

We have allocated a significant financial investment to support an organization based in Palestine, specifically for the preparation and distribution of meals catering to men, women, and children within the region. This commitment reflects our dedication to addressing critical humanitarian needs, ensuring that essential sustenance reaches vulnerable populations, and contributing to the well-being and nourishment of individuals and families in Palestine.



We have distributed 300 mattresses to families in Palestine, specifically in the regions of Arish, Rafah, Sheikh Zowaid, and El Mosaeeid. This initiative underscores our commitment to providing essential support and relief to communities facing challenging living conditions. By ensuring access to comfortable bedding, we aim to improve the quality of life for individuals and families, particularly in areas affected by ongoing hardships. This effort is part of our ongoing mission to address immediate needs and contribute to the well-being and resilience of Palestinian households.



We have distributed 500 meals to Palestinian families residing in the El Arish region, many of whom are classified as refugees. This endeavor reflects our deep-rooted commitment to alleviating food insecurity and supporting vulnerable communities. By providing nutritious meals, we aim to address immediate hunger challenges and contribute to the overall well-being and resilience of these families. This initiative is part of our ongoing efforts to stand in solidarity with refugees and marginalized populations, ensuring they have access to essential resources for a dignified and sustainable livelihood.



We have also visited Palestinian families in their homes, where we extended our heartfelt prayers and support. This meaningful interaction allowed us to connect on a personal level, offering spiritual guidance and comfort during challenging times. Our visit aimed to foster a sense of community and solidarity, emphasizing the importance of compassion and empathy in our humanitarian efforts. Through prayer and outreach, we hope to uplift and empower individuals and families, reinforcing our commitment to standing alongside them in their journey towards hope, healing, and resilience.



We have managed to furnishing of 20 apartments in El Arish, specifically designed to accommodate Palestinian refugees. Each apartment has been meticulously equipped to provide a comfortable and supportive living environment, featuring essential amenities such as beds, blankets, heaters, and kitchen supplies. Our commitment to refugee resettlement extends beyond mere shelter; we strive to create spaces that foster a sense of security, dignity, and stability for displaced individuals and families. By ensuring access to basic necessities and functional living spaces, we aim to facilitate a smooth transition and empower refugees on their journey towards rebuilding their lives.



We have provided essential medications to support the healthcare needs of 150 Palestinian individuals on a monthly basis. This initiative is part of our ongoing commitment to improving access to vital healthcare services in the region. By ensuring a steady supply of medications, we aim to contribute positively to the well-being and quality of life of those in need within the Palestinian community. This effort underscores our dedication to humanitarian values and our mission to make a meaningful difference in the lives of individuals facing healthcare challenges



We supported hospitals and medical aid tents in El Arish region that have been instrumental in treating wounded patients during times of conflict. We have contributed significantly by supplying essential medications, clothing, and footwear to these facilities, ensuring that they are equipped to meet the urgent needs of patients in distress.

Additionally, we have gone the extra mile by providing personalized assistance to patients, addressing their individual needs and requirements. Furthermore, our efforts have extended to enhancing mobility and comfort for patients by donating fourteen wheelchairs, facilitating their recovery process. In parallel, we have also addressed the issue of

hunger by distributing 100 nutritious meals to those in need




Prayer requests
